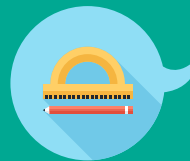
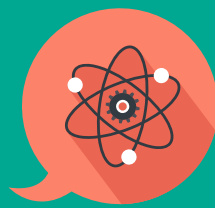


WISDOM FROM THE FRONT LINES
