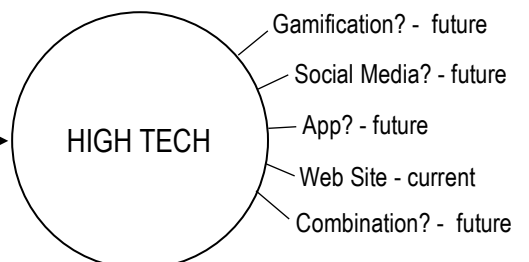
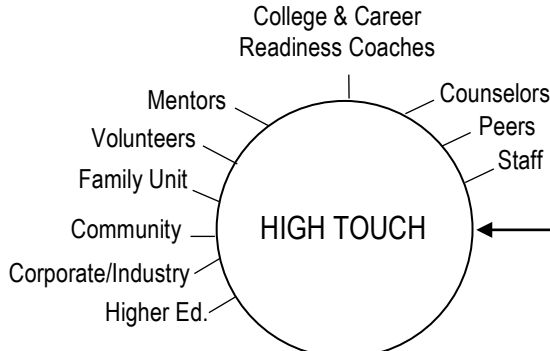
GO CENTERS AS HUBS FOR SPSS

WORK WITH GO CENTERS COORDINATORS/PRINCIPALS UTILIZING BEST PRACTICES FOR STUDENT SUCCESS

GOAL: Help FWISD students make informed decisions about career pathways and employment opportunities.

Employing information captured by community stakeholders:

- Initiate pilot program in 4 middle school Go Center locations that were utilized during the survey process.
- Create formula for success based on work to date.
- Develop materials, specifications and job descriptions to recruit, train, and attract needed resources (see below.)



- Determine roles
- Write job descriptions
- Develop recruitment/placement/orientation/management plan
- Define possible talent pools – Vision FW, Real Estate Council, Leadership FW
- Determine how other service providers fit in
